- The club has zero tolerance of any form of racial discrimination or abuse

Any breaches of the above will be brought to the committee's attention and suitable action will be taken. In serious cases an individual may be asked to leave the club.

We are affiliated to Berks and Bucks FA and if the breach is considered to be a safe guarding children issue we will follow the Berks and Bucks County FA's guidance and advice. (01367 242099)
